

## Fakolujo calls for Review of University Laws

The Vice-Chancellor, Joseph Ayo Babalola University (JABU), Professor Olasebikan Fakolujo has called for the review of the laws guiding the running of University for efficient productivity.

Speaking during an interactive session with the 2023 Visitation Panel set up by the Visitor of the University and President Christ Apostolic Church (CAC) Nigeria and Overseas, Pastor Samuel Oladele, Fakolujo said “there are some lacunars in the existing laws and for the University to move and be at par with its counterparts, there

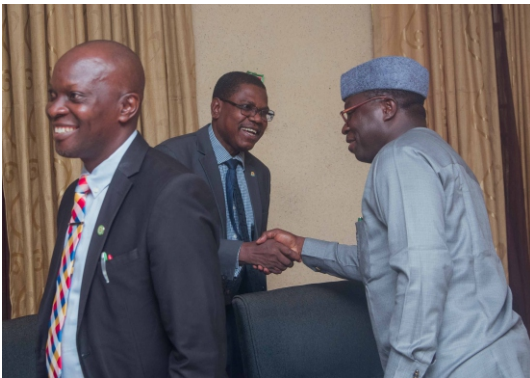
must be adequate review.”

During an interactive session with the members of Senate, the Chairman of the panel, Professor Emeritus Olufemi Adebisi Bamiro said, every university is supposed to have visitation panel every five years and its essence is to look into the system to know how the university is doing. “Through this exercise, the solutions can be proffered to the challenges in the system,” he added.

Speaking further, Bamiro said the panel is saddled with 10 points term of reference which will cover a period of 10 years (2013-2022)

within eight weeks. “This panel is covering period of 10 years because the last panel was wrongly inaugurated,” he said.

The seven-member panel has the former Vice-Chancellor of the Federal University of Ibadan, Professor Emeritus Olufemi Adebisi Bamiro, as Chairman, Barr. (Mrs) Olatundun Akindele as the secretary, Elder Kehinde M. Ogunbusola, Mr. Isaac Oyebode Oyeemi, Elder Femi Ogunwomoju, Mr. Akintoye Adebowale, and Pastor Gabriel O. Imoukhuede as members.
