# **Submitted Manuscripts Should Contain:**

- A short, informative title
- Author(s) name(s) and affiliations
- An abstract of not more than 250 words
- The main text: 500 6,000 words including all elements, abstract and references
- Referencing style should be the APA format
- Charts and figures should be created electronically
- A short biographical sketch about each author

Manuscripts submitted for publication in JIJSMS are considered on the understanding that they are not being offered for publication elsewhere, and have not already been published. The publishers of JIJSMS do not accept responsibility for the accuracy of the data presented in the articles or any consequences that may arise from their use. Opinions expressed in articles published by JIJSMS are solely those of the authors.

The title page and biographical data will be removed before the article is sent for peerreview. The reviewers' identities remain anonymous to authors. The review process may take 2-3 weeks after which the reviewers' comments will be sent to the author. When preparing the final of an article for JIJSMS, an author will be expected to conform strictly with the journal's style requirement. Use the following system for arranging your references.

### Reference and Reference Style

The responsibility for the accuracy of bibliographic citations lies entirely with the authors. Citations in the next should follow the referencing style used by the American Psychological Association (APA). Authors should also avoid using footnote. Authors are advised to change footnote to endnote and explain the note after references. The following examples serve as guide:
